Objet : Migration of the ALERT-C location table version in France

Dear Madam or Sir,

Road information can be delivered through different communication means. Relevant and accurate information needs an accurate description and location for each event.

The ALERT-C location table can be considered as a geographical reference data framework. It is the only harmonised location referencing system throughout Europe able to locate each traffic event on road networks. Table creation is defined by a European standard as well as an international standard (EN ISO 14819-3:2004). As any reference data framework the ALERT-C location table needs to be regularly updated to take into consideration road network evolution. The last version (V12.1) of the Alert-C table was certified by the organization Tisa (Traveller Information Services Association) on July 19th, 2018.

This table is used in different software components of road information systems especially in DATEX nodes inside the French ministry in charge of transports as well as in its partners' systems. It is convenient to organise a smooth version migration so as to avoid any data loss or service disruption.

Therefore, the current version (11.0) is scheduled to be shifted into the new one (12.1) on Wednesday, March 6, 2019 at 13:00 by the French ministry.


